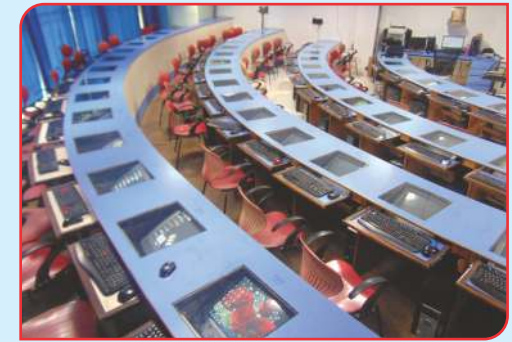

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Student must purchase the prospectus from office and carefully read all instructions.
- Student must fill the Admission Form required with prospectus.
- Student must completely fill-up and have to attach required documents with forms.

- Student should check Form & verified by enquiry counter and attach the Payment Slip to Form.

- If payment made by cheque, admission will be confirmed only after the clearance of the cheque.
- All admissions will be provisional and subject to confirmation by the University.

FEE INSTRUCTIONS:

Payment of Fees :

- As per the norms, Full amount of fee to be paid at the time of admission.
- College provides installation facility to the students to pay the fee under following terms –
- Students who take admission for various course need to pay 50% of the course fee at the time of admission.
- Remaining amount in one instalment payable by PDC. PDC not to exceed 10th September of the academic year.
- Late fee applicable if –

Instalments not paid by 10th of allotted month

- Post-dated cheque bounces.
- Extended instalments are allotted (if any)

- For students from Other State or Foreign Countries, the additional fees applicable as per university rule.
- Other Fee to be paid –
 - Eligibility Fee – To be paid from 30th July to 15th August (Only for new admission)
 - Exam Fee – To be paid for every semester separately as per University declaration.
 - Project Fee – Applicable according to project subject added to the courses/semester. Project to be paid along with exam fees.
 - Tour – For industrial Visit / Study tour charges will be applicable separately.
 - Apart from academics if any other function or activity for students are there then separate charges will be applicable.
- If there is any change in fee structure or rules for regulating admission in the institute as per the specified regulating body of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune will be informed by issuing circulars or notification in the institute notice board. The student has to pay the difference or hike in the fee for regulating admission in the institute.

RULES FOR REFUND OF FEE:

- The Refund of Fee is applicable as follows –
- 20% of amount will be deducted from the total course fee on cancellation of the admission between 1st day to 10th day from the date of securing admission.
- 40% of amount will be deducted from the total course fee on cancellation the admission between 11th day to 30th day from the date of securing admission.
- No Refund will be given under any circumstances if the admission is cancelled after 30 days.
- Refund of fee is through only by cheque and is to be collected after 15 days after submitting the original fee receipt with written application in person within the prescribed time limit.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE :

After successful completion of course, student is supposed to apply for issuance to transfer certificate among with prescribed amount fee and written application with xerox of last mark sheet to the institute office.

RULES & REGULATION:

For Students:

ANTI REGGING ACT-1999

Sec. 2(C) Ragging :

Ragging means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm raise apprehension or fear of shame or embarrassment in any educational institution and includes : teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students, or asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course,wilingly do.

S.3 Prohibition of ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.

S.4 Penalty for ragging : Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonments for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine may extend to ten thousand rupees.

S.5 Dismissal of Student : Any student convicted of an offence under S.4 penalty for ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution

S.6. Suspension of Student :

1) Whenever any student of as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complaints, in writing of raging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice of the forgoing provisions, withing seven days of the receipt of the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action.

2) Where, on inquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance prime facie, in the complainant received under subsection (1), he / she shall intimate the fact, in writing to the complainant.

3) The decision of the head of the educational institution that the student has indulged in ragging under subsection (1) shall be final.

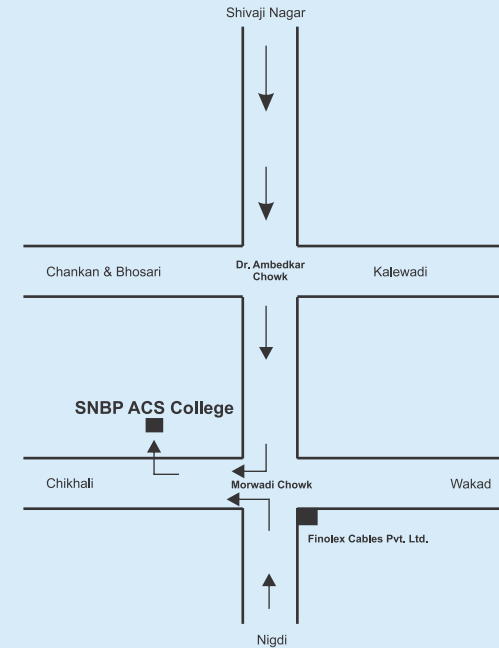
